

## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CERTIFICATE IN CHINESE

*Five of the following courses, totaling at least 15 credits, must be taken:*

CHN	487B,C,D	Readings in 20 <sup>th</sup> Century Chinese Literature (3) (Pre: 485 or 486)
CHN	491	Oral Fluency Through Chinese Films (3) (402)

\*CHN 204, 303 and 404 are accelerated versions of 201-202, 301-302 and 401-402, respectively, and are each counted as two courses.

\*\*CHN 331 and 332 are each repeatable once, but only one of each may be used towards the fulfillment of these requirements.

### NOTES:

- 1) Students may take up to two 200-level language courses (201 (4) and 202 (4), or equivalent).
- 2) Students must take at least three 300+ courses from the approved course list (check with the department).
- 3) All courses must be taken for a letter grade, and must be passed with a grade of "C" or better. In addition, the GPA for the courses together must be 2.5 or higher.
- 4) All courses must be taken within the University of Hawai'i system (with at least three taken at UH Manoa) or through a study abroad program directly administered by an official UHM organization (e.g., the Study Abroad Center) that is officially recognized by the Chinese Section of UHM's Department of East Asian Languages and Literatures.
